Today we travel via the Goulburn Highway to Nagambie where we board the Goulburn Explorer. This cruise is a return trip back to the Leisure Park and will include lunch on board. We then re-join the coach and travel by road to Chateau Tahbilk. We board the vessel at Nagambie Lakes Leisure Park and cruise through the scenic waterways and the Goulburn River.

You will have some free time here for tastings and a chance to browse around this historic winery before our return journey back to Epping.
