LINE DANCING MEMBERS PLEASE NOTE

In order to ensure the safety of all members a set of RULES have been developed. It is essential that all members who attend line dancing classes abide by these rules to ensure the safety of ALL PARTICIPANTS. Please contact the tutor should you have any questions relating to this matter.

Line Dancing Etiquette

Floor etiquette is required for the safety of dancers

1. Dancing should always be on either a wooden or laminated floor. Never on carpet or concrete
2. Wear covered in shoes with a sole that allows you to swivel your feet to prevent knee and ankle injuries.
3. **NEVER WALK THROUGH THE DANCE FLOOR WHILST A DANCE IS IN PROGRESS.**
4. If you want to get to the other side of the hall, go around the outside of the dancers.
5. When joining in on a dance already in progress, please don't push in to the middle of the floor. Dance in a vacant position on the edge of the dance floor and move to the middle of the floor when the dance finishes.
6. If you wish to leave the floor whilst a dance is in progress, carefully move along the row to the outside edge and leave the dance floor.
7. If you want to chat to friends whilst a dance is on, please stand to the edge of the dance floor, not in the middle of the floor.
8. If you don't know the steps to a dance and you want to watch the other dancers or the teacher, please stand to the side of the dance floor, not in the middle of the floor.
9. Give your fellow dancers room to move. Don't take up more room than you need.
10. Nobody has their 'own' spot on the dance floor. You may not be able to stand in the same spot each time you attend a class.
11. When dancing near beginners, be mindful and courteous. Everyone was a beginner once so please be encouraging towards them.
12. We all attend Line Dancing to have fun so please treat your fellow dancers and Tutor with respect at all times.
