Friends of the Royal Botanic Gardens Melbourne are hosting their 16th biennial exhibition of botanical art, "The Art of Botanical Illustration" this year.

The exhibition attracts submissions of exquisite art works from local and international botanical artists. All original artworks are for sale. A selection of works will be acquired for the State Botanical Collection held at the National Herbarium of Victoria as reference and for future generations. Profits from the exhibition are used by the Friends to support the Royal Botanic Gardens Melbourne and the Herbarium.

The exhibition will be held in the galleries at Domain House, Dallas Brooks Drive, Melbourne, located near the Royal Botanic Gardens Melbourne, and also online from 17 September until 2 October. Entry is free however a gold coin donation would be appreciated. The Exhibition will be open between 10.00 am and 4.00 pm each day and there is on-street parking available in the surrounding area.
