REDUCED SUBSCRIPTION FOR Whittlesea U3A ENROLMENT FOR BALANCE OF 2024

Beginning from this term the subscription for joining Whittlesea U3A during the second half of 2024 has been reduced. It is now \$45 for new members and \$40 for re-enrolments until the end of 2024. There are still many classes which have vacancies so becoming a member now will still give you 5 months of great outings, exercise classes, craft sessions etc.

REPLACEMENT LANYARDS

For those members who have misplaced their lanyards the cost of getting a new one is \$2 and \$1 for the plastic pocket. 2024 new members receive their lanyards regularly either by post or at the office upon enrolment. All other members will need to pay for a replacement as the cost of purchasing these items has increased dramatically. Please check at home before asking for a new lanyard if you would like to avoid the extra cost. These charges will be for purchases at either the Peter Lalor or the May Rd. campus. Postage costs may apply if you wish your lanyard posted.

TEA AND COFFEE AT MAY ROAD

We have been advised by the City of Whittlesea that we are responsible for the removal of all rubbish at all the venues we use. This often means that a small handful of members, usually volunteer tutors, are left to collect the rubbish and remove it to outside bins or take it home. In May Rd this has caused a problem because of the large number of disposal cups that are used and placed in bins. Some members could have anything up to 5 cups of tea/ coffee whilst there and they use a new disposable cup each time. This is bad for the environment and for the rubbish collection.

<u>For this reason from the beginning of this term tea and coffee will still be available however there will be no</u> <u>paper cups available.</u> If you wish to have a cup of tea or coffee you will need to bring your own cup and take it home when finished. Cups on the premises are not the property of Whittlesea U3A and cannot be used. It is not the responsibility of the tutors to clean up cups so please remember that they are volunteers when you leave your dirty cup in a sink or your rubbish on tables for them to clean up because you did not have time to clean up your one cup or throw out your sugar container. Thank you to all members who have been so helpful and positive in this matter.
